



English & Mathematics

In English, the children will continue to extend their phonic knowledge, reading fluency and pencil control as well as studying a range of texts including *It's My Birthday*, *How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth* and *Zim, Zam Zoom*. In Maths, the children will be focusing on developing their place value knowledge, addition and subtraction skills and learning about shape.

History & Geography

In Geography, the children will learn about the differences between weather and climate and about basic climate zones and the conditions in cold, hot and temperate climate zones. They will also learn how to collect and analyse weather data. To celebrate Black History month the children will be learning about Mary Seacole. They will also be learning about famous explorers in History lessons after half term.

Autumn Term

RE & PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be learning about how to live healthily and how to be a good friend.

In RE, the children will be learning about Islam, answering the question *Who is Muslim and how do they live?*. After half term they will be learning about Christianity and answering the question *Why does Christmas matter to Christians?*

Music

In Music, the children will be singing songs and playing instruments linked to their learning about the song *Tony Chestnut*. Additionally, they will be talking about pieces of music and designing their own musical conversation!

Science

In Science, the children will investigate and learn about the seasons Autumn and Winter. They will be investigating how plants, animal behaviour and how weather changes through these two seasons. Additionally, they will be focusing on every day materials, naming them, investigating with them and identifying how they can change.

Art & DT

In Art, the children will be developing their chromatic art skills so they will be using lots of colour and learning about abstract art. This term in DT the children will be cooking.

PE

In PE, the children will be focusing on the importance of fitness and revisiting the fundamental skills of running, jumping, skipping and hopping. Before moving on to Gymnastics and Ball skills after half term.

Computing

In Computing, the children will be introduced to the keyboard, learn how to add and remove text, explore the tool bar and learn different ways to change text. After half term they will learn how to look at and analyse data on a computer. The children will continue their learning about internet safety with fun stories about *Smartie the Penguin*.
