The classes will be on a 4 week rota throughout the year so they can experience the outdoors across all the seasons. A timetable will follow.

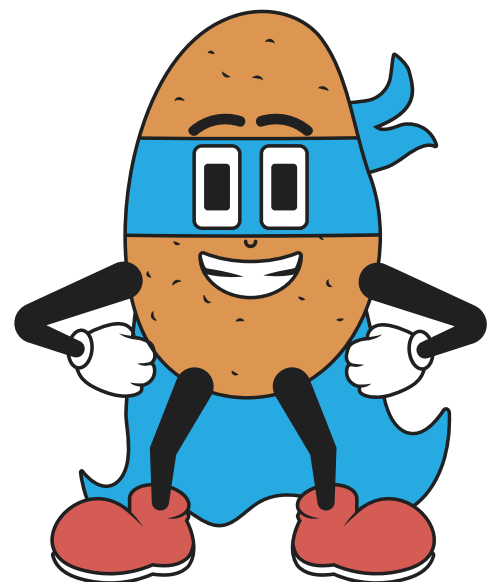
