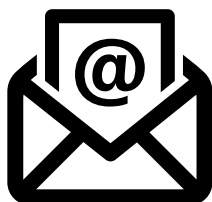
OFSTED

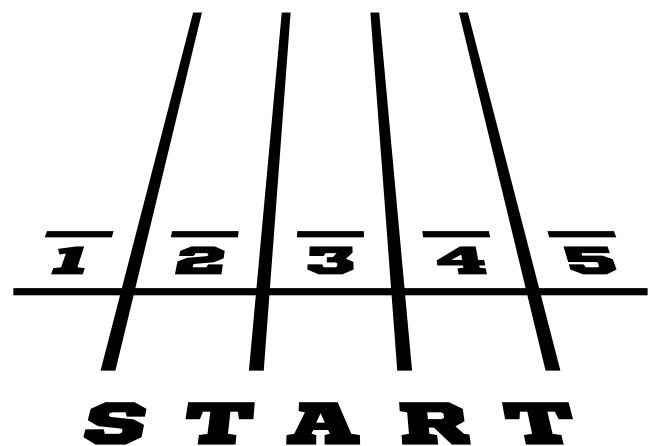
