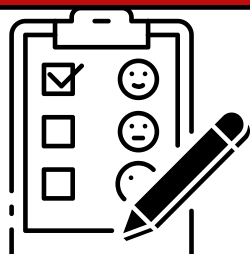
NEXT WEEK

Reindeer Run for Hospicare



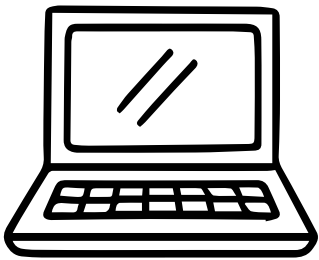

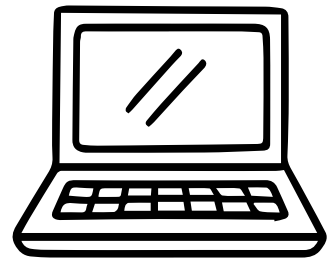
COMING SOON TO OUR SCHOOL
