

# English & Mathematics

This term in Maths, the children will be learning how to add and subtract within 100, multiply and divide, developing their understanding of length, height and statistics.

In English, the children will continue to extend their phonic knowledge, reading fluency and pencil control as well as studying a range of texts including No-bot the Robot with No Bottom, Hidden Worlds-Oceans and Mae Jemison.

# History

In History this term, the children will continue their learning about famous explorers before moving onto learning about hospitals and healthcare. The children will be introduced to Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell and learn about how they became significant and the impact their work had on health care today. They will also be able to reflect on their learning about Mary Seacole from Black History month and explore how her experiences of being a nurse were different.

# RE & PSHE

In PSHE this term, the children will be focusing on learning linked to the topic Boys, Girls and Families. The children will be reflecting on how boys and girls are different, learning about stereotypes and how families can be different. They will also be learning the scientific names for private parts.

In RE this term, the children will be exploring the questions "Who is a muslim and how do they live?" and "Why does Easter matter to Christians?"

# Spring Term Fox Class

## Art

This term in Art, the children will be doing painting. They will be learning about the artist Ted Harrison. The children will develop their knowledge of colour theory and create landscapes using complementary colours.

## Music

This term in Music, the children will be singing songs, playing instruments and composing their own pieces linked to the themes of "Grandma Rap", "Swing-a-long with Shostakovich" and "Charlie Chaplin."

# Science & Computing

In Science this term, the children will learn about different animals and their offspring. We will have trout eggs at school for the children to watch and explore how they change as they grow into fish. They will about the three things all animals need to survive and the human life cycle.

In Computing, the children will be focusing on Programming and Animations using ScratchJnr. Where they will begin to learn how to read code to predict what a programme will do. Additionally, they will continue their learning about data collection and learn how to create a pictogram on a laptop.

## PE

This term, the children will be focusing on Sending and Receiving, Teambuilding before moving on to Dance and Yoga in the second term.
