

Mr Marriott has informed us that the timber play area at school desperately needs to be replaced but the replacement cost is likely to be in the order of £10,000.

The PTFA intend to run a number of specific events during the course of the year such as the ones above - to try to raise as much of the total as possible, but we also decided that we would relaunch easyfundraising as a means of enabling parents and others to raise funds for the school without very much effort at all!

In essence (for those that don't know about it) you download the app and then whenever you make a purchase through certain connected sites, those sites will pay over a small percentage to your PTFA for nothing! In some cases (such as Amazon) you go through the app to the site to want to use which adds only a couple of seconds to the transaction. For most sites though, once you have downloaded the app, the donation taking place automatically.

Our treasurer started using the app recently and since then he has amassed total donations of £2.16 (from Amazon, Argos, Currys and so on). It doesn't sound much but if you multiply that over a whole year and by the number of parents and carers in the school community, we could raise substantial funds in a fairly short period of time.

When new supporters raise £5, easyfundraising will give Shute Community Primary School another free £5!

Mr Marriott signed up to the app during our last committee meeting and it took him only 30 seconds! Once you have downloaded the app, you just have to link it to our cause, Shute Community Primary School and then you're good to go.
